

## Navarro Pablo Perez

Pablo Perez Navarro holds a doctoral degree in Philosophy from the University of La Laguna. He was a research visitor at the Center of Lesbian and Gay Studies (CLAGS) at the NYU, and a postdoctoral researcher at Universidad Carlos III de Madrid, where he taught the course "Gender sex and Identity: an introduction to Queer Theory" for three academic years.

He is the author of *Del texto al sexo: Judith Butler y la performatividad* (Egales, 2008), and coauthor of collective works on Philosophy, Queer and Gender Studies, such as *Judith Butler en disputa. Lecturas sobre la performatividad* (Egales, 2012), *Teoria queer. Politicas bolleras, maricas, trans, mestizas* (Egales, 2005), *Conjunciones. Derrida y compania* (Dykinson, 2007) and *eticas y politicas de la alteridad. En torno a la obra de Gabriel Bello Reguera* (Plaza y Valdes, 2015). His recent articles address topics like queer masculinities, LGBTQ activism, contemporary social movements and radical politics of the street.

Nowadays, he is a research fellow at the Center of Social Studies of the University of Coimbra.
